Hello to all Village residents! The COVID-19 virus has had significant impacts on all of us. We, as a staff at the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, continue to stay informed through the information and best practices coming out from the various levels of government and health agencies.

In the interest of protecting the health of the residents and staff, the Village Hall will be closed for day to day operations starting on Monday, March 23rd, 2020, other than as follows:

Voting: The Village Hall will remain open for early voting as follows:

1—Friday March 20 through Wednesday April 1st from 8AM-2PM, Monday-Friday.

2—April 2nd and 3rd from 8AM-5PM.

**In the interests of protecting not only your health; but also the poll workers and staff, we are encouraging all residents who are able--to vote early or by absentee.

Police Services: The police department will be available as always 24 hours per day/ every day. The emergency number is 911. Dispatch center for non-emergency calls is 262-446-5070. The officer on duty has a cell phone for **non-emergencies calls only**—414-881-9727.

Woodlot: The woodlot will stay open on Saturdays from 9AM-1PM. The Village will not be borrowing keys to the residents for the immediate future. If you need to get into the woodlot, call the squad on duty on the cell phone—414-881-9727. As soon as possible, an officer will let you in.

Other Village Services: Please call the Village Hall at 262-567-5301 for an appointment. (New building permits, licenses etc.)

Building inspection: Set up an appointment with Tom Marks at 262-490-0513.

As information updates, the village staff will continue to communicate. As always be safe and stay smart in your decision making. Feel free to call the village hall between the hours of 8AM-2PM Monday through Friday.
