CHARTER ORDINANCE C-2

To Abolish the Offices of Village Constable and Village Marshal and Create the Office of Chief of Police

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

- (1) Offices of Marshal and Constable Abolished. Pursuant to Sections 61.195, 61.197 and 66.01 of the Wisconsin statutes, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake elects not to be governed by those portions of Sections 61.19 and 61.23 relating to the selection and tenure of constable and marshal and hereby abolishes the offices of Village Constable and Village Marshal.
- (2) Office of Chief of Police Created. There is hereby created the office of Chief of Police, which shall be filled by appointment by the Village President, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the members of the Village Board. The Chief of Police shall serve for an indefinite term, subject to removal by a majority vote of the Board. The Chief shall exercise the powers and duties of village marshals and village constables and any other powers and duties as provided from time to time by the Village Board.

Passed and adopted by a vote of two-thirds of the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, this 5th day of November, 1959.
