

Charter Ordinance C-3


To Establish Procedures for Removing and  
For Setting the Compensation of a Village  
Assessor Who is Also a Village Trustee

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

(1) Trustee Who is Assessor Not to Vote on Own  
Removal or Compensation. Pursuant to Section 66.01, Wisconsin  
Statutes, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake elects not to be  
governed by those portions of Sections 17.13 and 61.27 relating  
to removal and compensation of the village assessor when the  
village assessor is also a village trustee. In such a case,  
the village assessor who is also a trustee shall not be  
eligible to participate in the deliberation upon or discussion  
of these matters nor to vote thereon.

(2) Clerk's Duties; Effective Date. The village  
clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the  
Secretary of State of Wisconsin and shall cause a conformed  
copy hereof to be published in the Oconomowoc Enterprise.  
This Ordinance shall not be effective until sixty days after  
passage and publication in the manner aforesaid.

Passed and adopted by a vote of two-thirds of the  
Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha  
County, Wisconsin, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1960.


