

ORDINANCE NO. C-5

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to sections 61.195, 61.197 and 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake hereby elects not to be governed by those portions of sections 61.19 and 61.23 of the Statutes which relate to the selection and tenure of the Village Assessor and which are in conflict with this ordinance.

Section 2. Hereafter, instead of being elected, the Assessor of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake shall be appointed by vote of a majority of the members-elect of the Village Board.

Section 3. The term of said assessor shall be for one (1) year. Such term shall begin on May first succeeding the appointment.

Section 4. This ordinance shall not in any way affect the right of any person whose term of office has begun but has not expired on the effective date of this ordinance, to complete his term of office.

Section 5. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its passage and posting unless within such sixty (60) days a referendum petition shall be filed as provided by Section 66.01 of the Wisconsin statutes, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed and adopted by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, this 15th day of January, 1973.
