

ORDINANCE NO. 107

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 30

EROSION CONTROL

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

Resolved that Section 2.8 of Ordinance 30 of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

2.8 MAINTENANCE, EROSION CONTROL, AND USE OF SETBACK AND OFFSET AREAS.

All setback and offset areas shall be kept clean and free from any accumulation of debris or refuse and shall not be used for the storage or display of equipment, products, vehicles or any other material, except for the private storage of boats, fishing gear and other aquatic recreational equipment in regular seasonal use within such setback or offset areas. Setback and offset areas shall be maintained to minimize or eliminate the amount of sediment and other pollutants carried by runoff or discharged from construction sites to lakes, streams and wetlands.

Passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, upon recommendation of the Plan Commission and following a public hearing held upon public notice thereof, this 16th day of November, 1987.
