

ORDINANCE NO. 110.

WHEREAS, the Plat of Villa Gifford contains a roadway referred to as Whittimore Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the public health and safety of the residents of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake makes it imperative for the Village to adopt certain rules and regulations concerning the use of Whittimore Avenue, in order to insure the public safety and to provide for the orderly and peaceful use thereof by the Village residents and by the owners of lands in the Plat of Villa Gifford, and

WHEREAS, the lands designated and known as Whittimore Avenue are under the jurisdiction and control of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake,

RESOLVED, that the following rules and regulations shall apply to the use of the roadway area generally known as Whittimore Avenue.

1. Piers. There shall be no piers or wharfs constructed on or immediately contiguous to Whittimore Avenue.
2. Use. Whittimore Avenue shall be used for pedestrian traffic and for no other purposes.
3. Hours of Operation. Whittimore Avenue may be used between the hours of sunrise and sunset.
4. No Docking, Mooring and Storage. No docking of boats shall be permitted.
5. Swimming. There shall be no wading, swimming or diving.
6. Other Use Limitations. No uses are allowed which may be offensive to neighboring property owners. There shall be no alcoholic beverages consumed on Whittimore Avenue; no camp fires; no camping; no parties. The operation of motor vehicles and ATVs is strictly prohibited.


7. Closure. Whittimore Avenue may be closed to use by the general public by order of the Village Administrator, under direction of the Village Board of Trustees. Such order of closure may specify that Whittimore Avenue shall remain open for the use of residents within the Plat of Villa Gifford or for residents within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the penalty for the violation of any of the foregoing rules shall be a forfeiture for each violation of not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$100.00, together with court costs and assessments, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the 16th day of April, 1990, upon passage and publication as provided by law.




