

Ordinance No. 13

To Declare Untreated Dead Elm Tree  
Materials A Public Nuisance and To  
Provide For Inspections by Village  
Forester To Determine Whether Certain  
Public Nuisances Exist.

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 11 of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, adopted March 12, 1960, as amended by Ordinance No. 12 of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, adopted March 16, 1960, is hereby amended, effective after the passage and posting hereof, as follows:

Subsection (4) of section 6.02 is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"(r) Any dead elm tree or part thereof, including logs, branches, stumps, firewood or other elm material from which the bark has not been removed and burned or sprayed with an effective elm-bark-beetle destroying insecticide."


Subsection (1) of section 6.03 is amended by adding thereto, at the end thereof, the following:

"In order to discover whether there exists in the village any public nuisance of the sorts described in paragraphs 6.02(4)(q) and (r) hereof, the Village Forester or any agent or agents appointed by him, is empowered to enter upon any private premises in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, to examine any tree or part thereof, whether dead or alive, located or growing upon such premises, and, if it shall appear to the Village Forester or his agent or agents necessary or useful, to cut and take any sample deemed necessary by him from such tree or part thereof for diagnosis. No person

shall prevent, delay or interfere with the Village Forester or his agent or agents while they are engaged in any such entry, examination or sampling. After any such examination, the Village Forester shall make or cause to be made a written report of his findings to the Village President."


Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 6.03 is amended by striking therefrom the words and figures "within 24 hours" and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figure "in the manner directed within the period stated in such notice, which period shall not be more than five (5) days".
