AN ORDINANCE CREATING
CHAPTER 12
OF THE VILLAGE OF OCONOMOWOC LAKE MUNICIPAL CODE
ENTITLED
SHORELAND PROTECTION ORDINANCE

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake,
Waukesha County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Chapter 12 of the Municipal Code of the Village
of Oconomowoc Lake entitled Shoreland Protection Ordinance is
hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY. This several sections of this
ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or
portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent
jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such
decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion
thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect
the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions
thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall
remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose
terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are
hereby repealed as to those terms in conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take
effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as
provided by law.
