

Ordinance No. 14

To Restrict Use of Explosives and to Provide
Special Penalty for Certain Unauthorized Fires.

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 10 of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, adopted March 12, 1960, is hereby amended, effective after the passage and posting hereof, as follows:

Section 8.01 is amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

"(6) Use of Explosives Restricted. No person shall detonate any explosive within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake without first securing a written permit from the Village Clerk who shall issue such permit only upon approval of and subject to any conditions for the protection of life and property imposed by the Chief of Police."

Subsection (2) of section 8.05 is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"(c) Fires. ~~Any person who shall violate subsection 8.01 (3) of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit a sum equal to the cost to the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, if any, of having fire equipment and personnel sent to the scene of the fire and of extinguishing such fire, together with the costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs of prosecution are paid, but not to exceed 6 months. In the event that fire equipment and personnel are not so dispatched, penalties for violation of this subsection shall be as prescribed in~~

~~subsection (1) hereof. In no case shall a forfeiture levied under this subsection exceed the sum of \$200."~~




AFFIDAVIT OF POSTING
