ORDINANCE NO. 140

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE TIME
OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETINGS
OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 2 of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, adopted November 2, 1959, as amended by Ordinance No. 7, adopted November 16, 1959, as amended by Ordinance No. 16, adopted June 5, 1960, as amended by Ordinance No. 41, adopted August 19, 1963, the first sentence of subsection (1) of Section 1.01 is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

"Regular meeting of the Village Board shall be held on the third Monday of each calendar month at 7:00 P.M. and/or at such other dates and times as is timely noticed by the Village Clerk."

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY. The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any sections or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.


AFFIDAVIT OF POSTING
