

ORDINANCE NO. 144

AN ORDINANCE TO  
REPEAL AND RECREATE  
SECTIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 81  
AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE VEHICULAR TRAFFIC  
IN THE VILLAGE OF  
OCONOMOWOC LAKE, WISCONSIN

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 81, entitled An Ordinance to Regulate Vehicular Traffic in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Wisconsin; Section 1, entitled Provisions of State Law Adopted by Reference is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

SECTION 1: PROVISIONS OF STATE LAW ADOPTED BY REFERENCE.

Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, the current and future statutory provisions in Chapters 340 up to and including 348, Chapter 350 and Section 941.01(1), Wis. Stats., as well as the provisions of Chapter Trans. 305, Wis. Adm. Code, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic, exclusive of any provisions therein relating to penalties to be imposed and exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a term of imprisonment, are adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any current or future statute or Administrative Code section incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this ordinance. Any future additions, amendments, revisions or modifications of the statute or Administrative Code sections incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this ordinance in order to secure uniform statewide regulation of traffic on the highways, streets and alleys of this State.

SECTION 2: Ordinance No. 81, entitled An Ordinance to Regulate Vehicular Traffic in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Wisconsin; Section 2, entitled Speed Limits; subsection (2), entitled Speed Limits Decreased is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

SECTION 2: SPEED LIMITS.

(2) Speed Limits Decreased. With the approval of the State Highway Commission, if so required, the speed limits set forth in Section 346.57(4)(e), (f) and (g), Wis. Stats., are decreased as hereinafter set forth upon the following streets or portions thereof located within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake:

- (a) Fifteen (15) miles per hour on North Beach Road and West Beach Road between Newport Road and Gifford Road from April 16 through October 15; and Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on the balance of North Beach Road and West Beach Road.
- (b) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on North Beach Road and West Beach Road from October 16 through April 15.
- (c) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on North Gifford Road between Highway 16 and North Beach Road.
- (d) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on West Fairview Road between Highway 16 and the end of West Fairview Road.
- (e) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on North Hewitts Point Road between Highway 16 and the end of North Hewitts Point Road.
- (f) Fifteen (15) miles per hour on North Lake Club Circle between its two points of intersection with North Beach Road from April 16 through October 15; and Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on the balance of North Lake Club Circle.
- (g) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on North Lake Club Circle from October 16 through April 15.
- (h) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on West Armour Road between the Village limits and West Beach Road.
- (i) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on West Plank Road between Highway 16 East to the Oconomowoc River.
- (j) Twenty-five (25) miles per hour on Valentine Road between West Beach Road and the Village limits.
- (k) Thirty-five (35) miles per hour on Sawyer Road, now designated as C.T.H. P, between S.T.H. 16 and Pabst Road.
- (l) Forty-five (45) miles per hour on Pabst Road between C.T.H. P and the West Village limits.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
