ORDINANCE NO. 157

AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND ORDINANCE NOS. 4 AND 141
TO PRESCRIBE MEMBERSHIP OF
THE BOARD OF REVIEW
FOR THE VILLAGE OF OCONOMOWOC LAKE

WHEREAS, by charter ordinance, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake has abolished the office of Elective Village Treasurer and created the office of Appointive Village Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board for the Village of Oconomowoc Lake has named the Village Clerk the Village Clerk/Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Review is composed of the President, Treasurer and Clerk of the Village pursuant to Section 2.04 of Ordinance No. 4; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.04 of Ordinance No. 4 was amended by Ordinance No. 141 to repeal and recreate the membership of the Board of Review to allow the Board of Review to be composed of the President, Village Clerk/Treasurer, and one Village Trustee; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake wishes, based on the aforementioned actions, to modify the composition of the Board of Review.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, State of Wisconsin, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 4, entitled "To Prescribe Appointive Village Officials, the Duties Thereof, and General Regulations Governing all Village Officers", subsection 2.04 entitled "Board of Review", and amended by Ordinance No. 141, entitled "An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 4 to Prescribe Membership of the Board of Review for the Village of Oconomowoc Lake" is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

2.04 BOARD OF REVIEW. The Board of Review of the Village shall be composed of the President, Village Clerk/Treasurer, and a Village resident who may be a public official or a public employee, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the Village Board in May of each year, and each of the above-named members shall have the duties and powers prescribed in Section 70.47, Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 2: SEVERABILITY.


The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.


This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.


