ORDINANCE NO. 161

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND

SECTION 17.10

OF THE VILLAGE OF OCONOMOWOC LAKE

ZONING ORDINANCE

REGARDING THE DEFINITION OF BUILDING HEIGHT

The Village Board for the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Chapter 17 of the Municipal Ordinances of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake entitled Zoning Ordinance; subsection 17.10 entitled Definitions; subsection entitled Building Height is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

## 17.10 <u>DEFINITIONS</u>

## BUILDING HEIGHT

A point measured from a point five (5) feet above the lowest point of the exposed structure to the highest point of any roof of the structure.

## SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

## EFFECTIVE DATE. SECTION 3:

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
