

ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A HIGHER WARRANT SERVICE FEE
PURSUANT TO WISCONSIN STATUTES SECTION 814.705.

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: WARRANT SERVICE FEES.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 814.70, 814.705 and 814.71, Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake Police Department shall charge a warrant service fee of \$20.00 whenever the Department serves a warrant or a commitment order upon an individual, except that the statutory fee imposed by Section 814.70 shall apply if larger than \$20.00. Warrant service fees shall be deposited in the Village general fund. If there is more than one defendant or person to be served at a given address, the \$20.00 warrant service fee shall apply to each person served. If the person has warrants from multiple jurisdictions, the warrant service fee shall be assessed with regard to each such jurisdiction.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance


shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.


