

ORDINANCE NO. 219AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND VILLAGE OF OCONOMOWOC LAKE
NO. 4 REGARDING APPOINTMENTS TO THE PLAN COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Village President has deemed it to be appropriate from time to time to appoint Trustees to the Village of Oconomowoc Lake Plan Commission; and

WHEREAS, current Village ordinances differ from otherwise applicable State laws in this regard; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board intends to adopt the substantive and procedural requirements of Wisconsin Statutes Section 62.23(1) to allow appointments to be made to the Plan Commission in the statutory manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Village of Oconomowoc Lake Ordinance No. 4 entitled "To Prescribe Appointive Village Officials, the Duties Thereof, and General Regulations Governing all Village Officers", Section 2.05 entitled "Plan Commission" is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

2.05 PLAN COMMISSION.

1. The Plan Commission of the Village shall consist of seven (7) regular members and one alternate member. All members of the Plan Commission shall be appointed by the President, who shall be the presiding officer. The President shall appoint himself or herself to the Plan Commission and may appoint other Village elected or appointed officials, except that the Plan Commission shall always have at least 3 regular citizen members who are not Village officials. Citizen members shall be persons of recognized experience and qualifications and must be residents of the Village. It is anticipated that the alternate member will attend every meeting of the Plan Commission, but should only vote on a matter when a regular member is absent or for any reason does not vote on a matter.
2. The members of the Plan Commission shall be appointed to hold office for a period of 3 years. Appointments shall be made by the

President during the month of April for terms that expire in April, or any other time if a vacancy occurs during the middle of a term.

3. The Plan Commission shall have the duties and powers prescribed in Section 62.23, Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.


The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.




AFFIDAVIT OF POSTING


