


Ordinance No. 22

To Provide for Aggregate Listing of Tax Amounts on Tax Receipts

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

So long as this ordinance shall be in effect, the Village Treasurer of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, in lieu of entering on each tax receipt furnished him by the County Clerk the several amounts paid respectively for state, county, county school, village and all other taxes as provided in Section 74.08(1), Wisconsin Statutes or any successor statute thereto, shall enter only the aggregate amount of such taxes on such receipts and shall cause to be printed or stamped on such receipts the separate rate of each such tax.



ORDINANCE


Ordinance No. 22

(1) Opposite the entrance to the Oconomowoc Lake Club on the northern side of the road in front of the Club.

(2) On the west side of the bend on County Trunk Highway "P" at its junction with Lindsay Road.

(3) At the northeast corner of the junction of County Trunk Highway "P" and the private drive leading into the Borisch, Robinson, Morsell, et al. properties.
