ORDINANCE NO. 231

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 81 REGULATING VEHICULAR TRAFFIC IN THE VILLAGE OF OCONOMOWOC LAKE

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees adopted Ordinance No. 81 on February 19, 1979 regarding the regulation of traffic within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 81 has been amended from time-to-time; and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 349.07(8) permits the Village to authorize the placement of stop signs on roadways subject to the Village's exclusive jurisdiction by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that it is necessary to regulate westbound traffic at the intersection of West Beach Road and North Beach Road within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake to promote public safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, State of Wisconsin **DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Section 8, "Official Traffic Signs and Signals", of Ordinance No. 81, "An Ordinance to Regulate Vehicular Traffic in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Wisconsin, is hereby amended by the creation of subsection (3) to read as follows:

- (3) STOP SIGNS AUTHORIZED.

 Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 349.07(8), a stop sign shall be placed at the following location:
 - a. The intersection of West Beach Road and North Beach Road to control westbound traffic.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY. The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any

other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
