

Ordinance No. 77

To Provide for the Direct Annexation of Certain
Contiguous Territory.

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

In accordance with Section 66.021, Wisconsin Statutes, and a sufficient and valid petition filed with the Village Clerk on July 17, 1961, all that Territory, described as follows, shall be and the same herewith is annexed to the Village of Oconomowoc Lake:

All that part of Section 35, Town 8 North, Range 17 East, Town of Oconomowoc and Sections 1, 2 and 3, Town 7 North, Range 17 East, Town of Summit lying Easterly and Southerly of the following described reference line and between said reference line and the present boundaries of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, including the territory annexed thereto by ordinance dated November 3, 1960. Beginning of said reference line being a point at the intersection of the South line of the C.M. & St. P. Railroad right-of-way and the East line of said Section 35; thence Westerly along said South right-of-way line to a point on said right-of-way distant normal to and 200 feet West of the East line of Section 35; thence South $0^{\circ} 25' 20''$ East parallel to the East line of said Section 35, 3380 feet; thence South $84^{\circ} 34' 40''$ West 7660 feet to the West shore line of Oconomowoc Lake and containing 449 acres more or less.

From and after the date of this ordinance, the territory described above shall be a part of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Oconomowoc Lake whenever adopted.

If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to

any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by a vote of two-thirds of the elected members of the Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake the 14th day of August, 1961.


ORDINANCE NO. 27


(1) Opposite the entrance to the Oconomowoc Lake Club on the northern side of the road in front of the Club.
