

ORDINANCE NO. 275

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO.266
AS IT RELATES TO BOND AMOUNTS
FOR VIOLATIONS OF VILLAGE ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake Village Board adopted Ordinance No. 266 on or about August 20, 2012, which in part repealed and recreated the Bond Schedule for the Village of Oconomowoc Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Judge for the Lake Country Municipal Court by letter dated January 9, 2014, recommended that the municipalities under the jurisdiction of the Court review and revise the local municipal Bond Schedules; and

WHEREAS, Section 800.037 of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that the Municipal Court, with the approval of the governing body of the municipality, shall set the deposit schedule for all cases other than traffic and boating cases; and

WHEREAS, the revised Village of Oconomowoc Lake Non-Traffic Deposit Schedule attached hereto and incorporated by reference is being submitted to the Municipal Court for approval concerning citations issued beginning March 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, subject to the approval of the Municipal Court, the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake intends to confirm its approval of the revised Non-Traffic Deposit Schedule as provided in Section 800.037 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin **DOES HEREBY ORDAIN** as follows:

SECTION 1:

Ordinance No. 266 dated on or about August 20, 2014, Section 2, dealing with Chapter 25 entitled "Construction and Effect of Ordinances," Section 25.04 entitled "Penalty Provisions," subsection (5) entitled "Bond Schedule," is hereby repealed and recreated as follows:

(5) BOND SCHEDULE. The deposit amount and schedule required by Section 800.037, Wis. Stats., is hereby established as described in Exhibit A that is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Such deposit amount and schedule has been approved as necessary by the judge of the municipal court. The Village Board may by resolution at a Village Board meeting, after giving notice as required by the open meetings law, from time to time, by separate resolution, make amendments to the deposit amount and schedule which will be subject to the approval of the judge of the municipal court and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
