

Ordinance No. 28

To Provide for the Direct Annexation of Certain
Contiguous Territory.

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

In accordance with Section 66.021, Wisconsin Statutes, and a sufficient and valid petition filed with the Village Clerk on October 30th, 1961, all that Territory, described as follows, shall be and the same herewith is annexed to the Village of Oconomowoc Lake:

All that part of Section 35, Town 8 North, Range 17 East, Town of Oconomowoc and Sections 2 and 3, Town 7 North, Range 17 East, Town of Summit lying Southerly of the following described reference line and between said reference line and the present boundaries of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, including the territories annexed thereto by ordinances dated November 3, 1960, and August 1, 1961. Beginning of said reference line being a point at the intersection of the South line of the C.M. & St. P. Railroad right-of-way and the West line of the Roehl property as described in Volume 743, Page 393, Document Number 461615 of Waukesha County records; thence Easterly along said South right-of-way line to a point on said right-of-way distant normal to and 200 feet West of the East line of Section 35; containing 362 acres more or less.

From and after the date of this ordinance, the territory described above shall be a part of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Oconomowoc Lake whenever adopted.

If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by a vote of two-thirds of the elected members of the Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake the 20th day of November, 1961.

ORDINANCE


Ordinance No. 28
