

Ordinance No. 29

To Create A Water Safety Patrol Unit For The
Village of Oconomowoc Lake.

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

13.01 CREATION OF WATER SAFETY PATROL UNIT.

There is hereby created as a division of the Police Department of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, a water safety patrol unit which shall be known as the Water Safety Patrol of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake.

13.02 DUTIES.

The Water Safety Patrol of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake shall enforce all ordinances of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake now existing or hereafter enacted which regulate water traffic; boating, water sports, sea planes or the use or operation of boats and other craft, including motor vehicles, on icebound waters.

13.03 OFFICERS OF PATROL; DIRECTOR.

The officers of the Water Safety Patrol of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake shall be the officers of the Police Department of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake or such of them as shall from time to time be assigned to such Patrol by the Chief of Police of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake. The director of such Patrol shall be the said Chief of Police.

13.04 EQUIPMENT.

The Water Safety Patrol of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake shall be furnished with and maintain a fully equipped patrol boat for the execution of its duties.

13.05 REPORT TO CONSERVATION COMMISSION: TREASURER'S DUTIES.

The Treasurer of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake shall keep a detailed account of the costs incurred by the Village in the operation of the Water Safety Patrol of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake and of the receipts resulting from forfeitures imposed upon persons convicted of violations of ordinances of the sort described in section 13.02 hereof and, on or before December 1st of every year commencing in 1962, shall file a detailed statement thereof for the preceding fiscal year with the Wisconsin Conservation Commission on the forms prescribed by it.

13.06 SEVERABILITY, EFFECTIVE DATE AND CLERK'S DUTY.

(1) Severability. The several sections and subsections of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any section or subsection of this ordinance shall be finally declared by a decision of a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this ordinance.

(2) Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and posting as provided by law.

(3) Clerk's Duty. The Village Clerk is directed to file a copy of this ordinance and of any subsequent amendments hereto with the Wisconsin Conservation Commission at Madison, Wisconsin.

ORDINANCE


ORDINANCE NO. 29
