Ordinance No. 38

An Ordinance To Amend Ordinance No. 10 Entitled
"An Ordinance to Prohibit Disorderly Conduct"

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 8.01 (1) and (2) of Ordinance Number 10, passed the 12th day of March, 1960, is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

(1) Discharging and Carrying Firearms and Other Weapons Regulated. Except as hereinafter provided, no person shall fire or discharge any firearm, spring or air-gun of any description, or other weapon, including a bow and arrow or slingshot, within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, or have any firearm, spring or air-gun, or other weapon in his possession or under his control unless it is unloaded and knocked down or enclosed within a carrying case or other suitable container.

(2) Exceptions:

(1) Law enforcement officers duly designated by the Village, County, State or Federal authorities.

(2) Persons carrying current hunting licenses issued by the State of Wisconsin may, during legal hunting seasons, hunt on their own land or upon the land of another with written consent of the owner or occupant, with bow and arrow or shotgun. The term "shotgun" shall mean only such guns as are classified in the "scattergun" category, equipped with smooth bored barrels.

(3) Shotguns may also be fired on private skeet or trap shooting grounds, provided a written permit is first obtained from the Village Board. Any application for such a permit must be accompanied with written consent from the property owners whose lands immediately adjoin the property upon which the skeet or trap shooting ground is to be located.

(4) Bows and arrows, slingshots and air rifles may be discharged upon an owners's property or upon the property of another with written permission, provided the same are fired at targets provided for that purpose, which targets are so located as to protect the property and safety of other persons.

(5) Such weapons as have been classified may be used for purposes of rodent eradication upon an owner's land provided written permission for such use is first obtained from the Village Board.

(3) Parental Responsibility. Any parent who knowingly allows a minor child to violate the above regulations shall be subject to the same penalties as are provided for the violator.

Section 2. Except as hereinafter provided, said ordinance Number 10 shall remain in full force and effect as originally passed.


Subsection 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and posting.

ORDINANCE


