

Ordinance No. 52

Amendment to Ordinance No. 31, To
Control Fires

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

Paragraph (2), Sec. 15.04 of Ordinance #31 is hereby deleted in its entirety. This paragraph to be replaced by the following:

Section 15.04 Penalties

- (2) If the services of a Fire Department is necessary to extinguish a fire that has gone out of control because of violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, the person responsible will be required to pay to the Village the sum of \$100.00 which will be credited to the Village Fire Protection budget.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and posting.

ORDINANCE


Ordinance #52 - Amendment to Ord. #31,
