ORDINANCE NO. 51

Amendment to Ordinance No. 9

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake doe ordain that Ordinance No. 9 Section 7.05, is amended to read as follows:

7.05 WEIGHT LIMITATION; CLASS "B" HIGHWAYS DESIGNATED.

(1) All of the streets and alleys within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake described in Appendix 4 hereto, which ~~is herewith~~ made a part of this ordinance just as if here set out at length, are hereby designated Class "B" highways and shall be subject to the weight limitations imposed by Section 348.16, Wisconsin Statutes.

(2) Pursuant to Section 349.17 (1), Wisconsin Statutes, heavy traffic as defined in Section 7.05 (3) is prohibited from operating within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake on West Beach Road, North Beach Road and Gifford Road, except that heavy traffic may use said roads for the purpose of obtaining orders for supplies or moving or delivering supplies or commodities to or from any place of business or residence within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake.

(3) In this section, "heavy traffic" means all vehicles not operating completely on pneumatic tires and all vehicles or combination of vehicles, other than motor busses, designed or used for transporting property of any nature and having a gross weight of more than 6,000 pounds.

This ordinance shall take effect after passage and posting as required by law.
