

ORDINANCE No. 6

To Provide for the <sup>Temporary</sup> Regulation of Building  
Construction in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:


The provisions of the Building Code of the Town of Summit, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Summit on September 25, 1952, are hereby adopted as the Building Code of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake and such provisions are incorporated by reference as though set forth at length herein; provided, that all references in such Building Code of the Town of Summit to the "Building Inspector" or "Town Building Inspector" shall be deemed to refer to the Building Inspector of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, all references therein to the "Town Board" shall be deemed to refer to the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, all references to "town" or "Town of Summit" shall be deemed to refer to the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, and all references to the "Town Zoning Ordinances" shall be deemed to refer to the Zoning Ordinances of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake.

This ordinance shall take effect on the day after proof of posting thereof shall have been filed and recorded in the office of the Village Clerk in accordance with Section 61.50, Wisconsin Statutes. A copy of the Building Code of the Town of Summit which is incorporated herein by reference shall be attached to and posted with each copy of this ordinance posted in accordance with Section 61.50, Wisconsin Statutes, and shall be filed and recorded by the Village Clerk in the Ordinance Book in conjunction with this ordinance.
