Ordinance No. 60

Administrator Ordinance

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 4, Section 2.01 shall be amended to read as follows:

"2.01 ATTORNEY, VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, BUILDING INSPECTOR and CHIEF OF POLICE

The Attorney, Village Administrator and Chief of Police of the Village shall each be appointed by the President, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the Village Board. The President shall not vote on confirmation, except in case of a tie. The terms of office of such officials or employees shall commence immediately upon confirmation of appointment and shall be indefinite, except as otherwise provided; each such official shall be subject to removal by a majority vote of the Board.

2.01 (a) VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR

- (1) APPOINTMENT. In order to coordinate and improve the various municipal services rendered to the Citizens of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake by the Village government, there is hereby created the office of Village Administrator. The Village Administrator shall be appointed by the Village President, subject to confirmation by the Board of Trustees, for an indefinite term, or for such term and at such salary as set by the Board of Trustees.
- (2) DUTIES. The Village Administrator, under the direction of the Board of Tustees, shall have the following duties:
 (a) Serve in the general administration of the Village at the direction of the President with the approval of the

Board of Trustees.

(b) Serve as Building and Zoning Inspector.
