An Ordinance to Regulate the Use  
and operation of Snowmobiles  
in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:


Section 1. State Snowmobile Laws Adopted. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, the statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to snowmobiles in the following enumerated section of the Wisconsin statutes are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Acts required to be performed or prohibited by such statutes are required or prohibited by this ordinance.

- 350.01 (Definitions)
- 350.02 (Crossing highways)
- 350.03 (Operation of Snowmobiles on or in  
Vicinity of a Highway)
- 350.04 (Snowmobile Races, Derbies and Routes)
- 350.05 (Persons under 12 Operating a Snowmobile)
- 350.06 (Firearms and Bows)
- 350.07 (Driving Bear, Deer or other Game Prohibited)
- 350.08 (Owner Permitting Operation)
- 350.09 (Head Lamps, Tail Lamps and Brakes)
- 350.10 (Miscellaneous Provisions for Snowmobile  
Operation)
- 350.11 (Penalties)
- 350.12 (Registration of Snowmobiles)

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and posting. This ordinance was adopted by the Village Board on the 17th day of January, 1972.
