An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 32 entitled "Water Traffic, Boating and Water Sports Upon the Village of Oconomowoc Lake and Prescribing Violation Thereof."

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 16.16 and 16.17 are hereby re-numbered as Sections 16.17 and 16.18 respectively.

Section 2. Section 16.16 is hereby created to read as follows:

Section 16.16, RESIDING ON BOATS

No persons shall use or occupy, temporarily or permanently, any boat on the waters subject to this ordinance as a dwelling or residence.

Section 3. Except as herein provided, said Ordinance No. 32 shall remain in full force and effect as originally passed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and posting.
