ORDINANCE NO. 73

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinances No. 10  
and No. 38, Entitled "An Ordinance to  
Prohibit Disorderly Conduct."

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake to prohibit hunting with firearms within the corporate limits of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, such action being necessary for public safety and to promote the public well-being,

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 8.01 (2) of Ordinance No. 10, as amended by Ordinance No. 38 of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

(2) Exceptions:

(a) Law enforcement officers duly designated by the Village, County State or Federal authorities.

(b) Shotguns may be fired on private skeet or trap shooting grounds, provided a written permit is first obtained from the Village Board. The application for permit must be accompanied by the written consent of the property owners whose lands immediately adjoin the property upon which the skeet or trap shooting ground is to be located.

(c) Bows and arrows, slingshots and air rifles may be discharged upon an owner's property or upon the property of another with written permission, provided the same are fired at targets provided for that purpose. The targets must be located so as to protect the property and safety of other persons.

(d) Weapons classified and used for purposes of rodent eradication, provided written permission for such use is first obtained from the Village Board.
