AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 78
TO ALLOW UNIFORM DWELLING CODE
TO APPLY TO EXISTING DWELLINGS

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc
Lake of Waukesha County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Sub-section 1 of Section 1. Uniform Dwelling Code
shall be revised to read as follows:

- (1) The State of Wisconsin, Administrative Code, Chapter Ind 20-25, Uniform Dwelling Code, as adopted and effective December 1, 1978 is adopted and incorporated in this code by reference. Administrative Code, Chapter Ind 20-25, Uniform Dwelling Code, as adopted herein, shall specifically apply to additions to existing dwellings as well as new construction.
