

ORDINANCE NO. 80.

An Ordinance to Amend Ordinance No. 64 of the
Village of Oconomowoc Lake
Regulation of Vehicular Traffic

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake of Waukesha County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

I. Section one (1) is hereby corrected by deleting the following:

346.04 (1) and (2), 345.06 to 346.16 (DRIVING, MEETING, OVERTAKING AND PASSING)

and substituting in place thereof:

346.04 (1) and (2), 346.05 to 346.16 (DRIVING, MEETING, OVERTAKING AND PASSING).

II. Section one (1) of Ordinance 64 is hereby amended by adding thereto:
342.40 (Vehicle Abandonment Prohibited; Removal; Disposal).

III. Section 11 of Ordinance 64 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. Reference to Statutes. References to specific statutory sections wherever used in this ordinance shall mean the Wisconsin Statutes of 1977 as amended on the effective date of this ordinance, and all amendments thereto.

This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after the 18th day of December, 1978, upon passage and publication as provided by law. All other sections of Ordinance 64, as amended to date, not specifically referred to herein shall remain in full force and effect.
