

ORDINANCE NO. 84
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 8 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 53
AND ORDINANCE NO. 77


The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

Section 5.03 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.03 DEFINITIONS:

1. The term "subdivision" as used herein is a division of a lot, parcel or tract of land by the owner thereof or by his agent for the purpose of sale or of building development, where:
 - (a) The act of division creates five (5) or more parcels or building sites of $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres each or less in area; or
 - (b) Five (5) or more parcels or building sites of $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres each or less in area are created by successive divisions within a period of five (5) years.

Passed and adopted by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, upon recommendation of the Village Plan Commission and after a public hearing thereon held upon due public notice thereof, this 18th day of August, 1980.
