

Ordinance No. 7

To Regulate Traffic and Vehicles.

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

7.01 STATE TRAFFIC LAWS ADOPTED.

The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic in the following enumerated sections and chapters of the Wisconsin Statutes, exclusive of any provisions therein relating to the penalties to be imposed or the punishment for violation of said Statutes, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this ordinance:

7.02 SPEED LIMITS.

(1) Increase in Limits. Pursuant to section 349.11 (3) (c), Wisconsin Statutes, the speed limits set forth in section 346.57, Wisconsin Statutes, are increased as set forth in, and upon the streets or portions of streets described in Appendix 1 A hereto which is herewith made a part of this ordinance just as if here set out at length.

(2) Decrease in Limits. *SEE ORD 46 SEC. 2*

(a) Pursuant to ~~section 346.57 (4) (i), Wisconsin Statutes, the speed limit on all streets within and adjoining all public parks and recreational areas in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake is hereby reduced to fifteen (15) miles per hour at all times when children are playing within or going~~

~~to or from said parks or areas. The streets, parks and areas herein concerned are more particularly described in Appendix 1 B hereto which is herewith made a part of this ordinance just as if here set out at length.~~

~~(b) Pursuant to section 349.11 (3)(e), Wisconsin Statutes, the speed limits set forth in section 346.57, Wisconsin Statutes, are decreased as set forth in and upon the streets or portions of streets described in Appendix 1C hereto which is herewith made a part of this ordinance just as if here set out at length.~~

7.03 THROUGH STREETS DESIGNATED. *SEE ORD. 46 SEC. 4*

Pursuant to section 349.07(3), Wisconsin Statutes, in the interest of public safety, the streets in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, described in Appendix 2 hereto, which is herewith made a part of this ordinance just as if here set out at length, are hereby declared to be through streets. All vehicles approaching such through streets shall stop behind the crosswalk at the intersection of any other street with such through streets.

7.04 PARKING LIMITATIONS. *SEE ORD. 46 SEC. 5*

~~Pursuant to section 349.13, and subject to the exceptions set forth in section 346.50, Wisconsin Statutes:~~

~~(1) Parking Limits. When signs are erected in any block of any street described in Appendix 3 hereto, which is herewith made a part of this ordinance just as if here set out at length, giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the period specified in Appendix 3 at any time between the hours of 8 A.M. and 6 P.M. except on Sundays and the holidays listed in section 256.17, Wisconsin Statutes.~~

~~(2) All-Night Parking Prohibited. No person, except physicians on emergency calls, shall park any vehicle for a period of time longer than thirty (30) minutes between the hours of 2 A.M. and 6 A.M. of any day on any public highway or street in the Village.~~

7.05 WEIGHT LIMITATIONS; CLASS "B" HIGHWAYS DESIGNATED.

All of the streets and alleys within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake described in Appendix 4 hereto, which is herewith made a part of this ordinance just as if here set out at length, are hereby designated Class "B" highways and shall be subject to the weight limitations imposed by section 348.16, Wisconsin Statutes.

7.06 BARRIERS FOR PLAY PURPOSES.

Pursuant to section 66.046, Wisconsin Statutes, the Chief of Police may, from time to time, set aside any street or alley that is not part of any federal, state or county trunk highway system, for coasting or other play activities. When any such street or alley is so set aside, the Chief of Police shall cause to be erected and maintained thereon barriers or barricades, including lights and warning signs therefor, for such period of time and in such manner as shall most effectively safeguard persons playing thereon from accidents.

7.07 YIELD RIGHT OF WAY INTERSECTIONS.

Operators of vehicles on the streets described in Appendix 5 hereto, which is herewith made a part of this ordinance just as if here set out at length, shall yield the right of way to vehicles on the intersecting street at the intersections described in Appendix 5 in accordance with section 346.18(4), Wisconsin Statutes.

7.08 ERECTION OF SIGNS AND SIGNALS.

The Chairman of the Public Works Committee is hereby authorized and directed to procure, erect and maintain appropriate standard traffic signs, signals and markings conforming to the rules of the State Highway Commission giving such notice of the provisions of sections 7.02, 7.03, 7.04, 7.05, 7.06 and 7.07 of this ordinance as is required by State law. Signs shall also be erected in such other locations and manner as may be authorized by the Village Board so as to give adequate warning to users of the street, alley or highway in question.

7.09 PROCESSIONS OR ASSEMBLAGES ON HIGHWAYS. *SEE ORD. 58*

No procession or assemblage which will or may obstruct any street or alley in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake for more than five (5) minutes shall be held except on not less than fourteen (14) days prior written notice to the Chief of Police or his deputy.

7.10 ~~POWER-DRIVEN CYCLES AND MOTOR BICYCLES.~~

~~No more persons shall ride a power-driven cycle or motor bicycle than there are seats on such vehicle. No power-driven cycle or motor bicycle shall be operated upon any street or alley in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake between the hours of 10 P.M. and 8 A.M.~~

7.11 REPORTS OF ACCIDENTS.

Any person required by section 346.70(2), Wisconsin Statutes, to forward a written report to the motor vehicle department of an accident occurring within the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, shall within the period therein established file with the Chief of Police a copy of such report.

7.12 PENALTIES.

(1) General Penalty.

(a) First-Offense-Penalty. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance, except those described in subsection (2) hereof, shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$1 nor more than \$100, together with the costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.

(b) Second-Offense-Penalty. Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance who shall have been previously convicted of a violation of this ordinance within one year prior thereto, shall, except as provided in subsection (2) hereof, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than

\$10 nor more than \$200 for each such offense, together with the costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs of prosecution are paid, but not to exceed six (6) months.

(2) Special Penalties.

(a) Speeding-Penalty. Any person who shall violate any provision of section 7.01 of this ordinance, described and defined in sections 346.57 and 346.58, Wisconsin Statutes, or of section 7.02 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 for the first offense, and, for the second and each subsequent conviction within one year thereafter, shall forfeit not less than \$20 nor more than \$200 together with the costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of any such forfeiture and costs, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs of prosecution are paid, but not to exceed six (6) months.

(b) Reckless and Drunken Driving-Penalty. Any person who shall violate any provision of section 7.01 of this ordinance, described and defined in sections 346.61 through 346.64, Wisconsin Statutes, shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$75 nor more than \$200 for each such offense together with the costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs, shall be imprisoned in the county jail until said forfeiture and costs of prosecution are paid, but not to exceed six (6) months.

(3) Traffic Safety School.

The provisions of section 345.16, Wisconsin Statutes, shall apply to adjudications of violation of any provisions of this ordinance.

7.13 ENFORCEMENT.


(1) Stipulation of Guilt. The Chief of Police or officer designated by him, upon request of any person charged with a violation of any provision of this ordinance within

to make uniform the traffic laws of this state and hereby to create civil actions to recover fines for the violation of this ordinance and to authorize punishment as a means of enforcing payment of the fine and costs. This ordinance shall not be construed as authorizing the creation of any crime or the imposition of criminal punishments.

(3) Statutory References. References herein to sections of the Wisconsin Statutes shall be deemed to include all amendments to or substitutions for such statutory provisions made after the date of adoption of this ordinance.

(4) Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and posting, except that subsection 7.02(2)(b) shall take effect only after approval of the state highway commission.

Sum to be forfeited pursuant to stipulation for violation of Section 7.05(2) is \$25.00 and \$50.00 to \$100.00 for each additional offense.



RESOLVED, That the Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake does hereby amend Ordinance No. 9 by adding thereto the following section:




