

ORDINANCE NO. 96

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 30 TO
INCREASE ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL BOARD
MEMBERSHIP TO SEVEN MEMBERS

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

RESOLVED, that Zoning Ordinance No. 30, as amended to date, be further amended in the following respects:

1. By amending Section 7.3 to read as follows:

7.3 MEMBERSHIP

The Architectural Control Board shall consist of seven (7) residents of the Village appointed by the Village President subject to confirmation by the Village Board of Trustees. At least one (1) citizen plan commissioner, and one (1) real estate broker, real estate appraiser, registered architect or registered professional engineer shall be appointed to such Architectural Control Board.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the remainder of this Section 7.3 stands as originally intended and written.

Passed and adopted by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, upon recommendation of the Village Plan Commission and after a public hearing thereon held upon due public notice thereof, this 19th day of November, 1984.
