

ORDINANCE NO. 97.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF  
ABANDONED PROPERTY

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Wisconsin, does  
ordain as follows:

Section 1. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, the  
statutory provisions covering the disposal of abandoned property, Section 66.28  
Wis. Stats., are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance  
as if fully set forth herein. Acts required to be performed or prohibited by  
this statute are required or prohibited by this ordinance.

Section 2. Personal property which has been abandoned or has remained unclaimed  
for a period of 30 days after the taking of possession of the property by the  
Village of Oconomowoc Lake may be disposed of at private sale in any commercially  
reasonable manner. Private sale shall proceed under the direction of the Village  
Board of Trustees. All such sales shall be without warranties or representations  
and shall be final.

Section 3. Property held as evidence which cannot, for any reason, be disposed  
of under Section 968.20 Wis. Stats. shall be considered abandoned or unclaimed property  
and shall be promptly disposed of by the Chief of Police in any reasonable manner.  
The Chief of Police shall maintain a record showing the date and manner of disposition  
for all such property.

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and posting. This ordinance  
was adopted by the Village Board on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1984.


