

ORDINANCE NO. 98.

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 62  
To Regulate the Use and Operation of  
Snowmobiles in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. Ordinance 62 is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. State Snowmobile Laws Adopted. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, the statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to snowmobiles in the following enumerated section of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Acts required to be performed or prohibited by such statutes are required or prohibited by this ordinance.

350.135	(Interferences with uniform trail signs and standards prohibited)
350.15	(Accidents and accident reports)
350.17	(Enforcement)
350.99	(Parties to a violation)

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and posting. This ordinance was adopted by the Village Board on the 19 day of November, 1984.
