**WHEREAS**, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

**WHEREAS**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

**WHEREAS**, an adopted all hazard mitigation plan is required by FEMA as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects under FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake participated jointly in the planning and update process with Waukesha County and other local units of government to prepare an All Hazard Mitigation Plan, which was made available for review and will reside permanently in the Waukesha County Office of Emergency Management; and


