COMMUNICATIONS: Mr. Roberts reported on the following:

1) The Clerk applied for a scholarship to the Municipal Clerk's School at University of Wisconsin/Green Bay for the week of July 9, 1989. The Municipal Clerks Education Foundation of the International Institute of Municipal Clerks awarded her a \$200 tuition scholarship and the Wisconsin Municipal Clerks Association granted her a scholarship for the balance of the tuition. She will have to pay for travel and housing accommodations. Motion was made by Mr. Fischer, seconded by Mr. Meyer, for approval of this expense out of the budget, and CARRIED.

2) The Clerk read the letter of Ted Templeton dated April 14, 1989, thanking Mr. Roberts for the fine job he has done as Village president. He has learned many things from Mr. Roberts, but the one that will stay prominently in his mind is that land owners change but what we let happen to the land will be there forever.
