

RESOLUTION NO. 54A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING REDUCTION
OF POLL WORKERS

WHEREAS, Section 7.30(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that there be 7 inspectors for each polling place at each election; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 15 in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake at Section 9.04(1) requires that there shall be 3 inspectors, 2 election clerks, and 2 ballot clerks for each polling place at each election, but provides that one person may, from time to time, simultaneously hold two (2) or more different offices, as directed by the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, Section 7.32 of the Wisconsin Statutes allows the governing body of any municipality, by resolution, to reduce the number of election officials; and

WHEREAS, the number of anticipated voters in any election may not warrant a full complement of poll workers,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake that the Village Clerk hereafter be authorized to provide fewer than 7 poll workers for each election when it is in the best interest of the electorate of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake; and

FURTHER, be it resolved by the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake that the Village Clerk hereafter be authorized to assign one person, from time to time, to simultaneously hold two (2) or more different election offices.
