NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this governing body that it, by this resolution, acknowledges the work of the Mediation Center of Waukesha County to help people resolve conflicts; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED by this governing body that it will use the services of the Mediation Center of Waukesha County in appropriate situations.
