A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE  
THE LAW OFFICE OF de la Mora & de la Mora  
TO REPRESENT THE VILLAGE OF OCONOMOWOC LAKE  
REGARDING A COOPERATIVE BOUNDARY PLAN

WHEREAS, de la Mora & de la Mora, has represented the Town of Summit with respect to a personnel complaint filed in regard to the Town Police Department, and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake (hereinafter "Village"), and, the Town of Summit (hereinafter "Town") have indicated an interest in negotiating a Cooperative Boundary Plan pursuant to the provisions of §66.023 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and,

WHEREAS, de la Mora and de la Mora, have advised both the Town Board and the Village Board that they do not believe that a conflict of interest exists in regard to representation of the Village with regard to the prospective Cooperative Boundary Plan, and,

WHEREAS, both the Village and the Town recognize that no conflict of interest exists in this regard, and

WHEREAS, the Town has determined that the representation of the Village by de la Mora & de la Mora, will not adversely affect the Town,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake hereby consents to de la Mora & de la Mora, representing the Village's interest with regard to the above-referenced Cooperative Boundary Plan.
