Motion (Barquist/Waltersdorf) to approve the minutes as printed, for the Plan Commission meeting held on February 15, 2016, *Carried Unanimously*.

Discussion/action regarding renewal of the Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for Ewald Kia, located in the business district of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake at 36883 E. Wisconsin Avenue, Oconomowoc, Wisconsin.

Motion (Bickler/Owens) to recommend approval to the Village Board of Trustees renewal of the Conditional Use Permit for Ewald Kia, located in the business district of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake at 36883 E. Wisconsin Avenue, Oconomowoc, Wisconsin adding Saturday hours from 7:00am to 5:00pm and a June expiration month, *Carried Unanimously*.

Discussion/action regarding Chapter 17 of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake Zoning Code relating to the regulation of signs.

Attorney Macy explained the Supreme Court decision regarding the regulation of signs. Ordinances can regulate location, size, lit v. unlit, and electronic signs, but cannot regulate any content as it would violate first and 14th Amendment rights.

Political signs are regulated by State Statute and our Ordinance should reference that statute.

After discussion on the current culture of the Village and other ordinances that will be affected, the Plan Commission will continue discussion and possible action on this item at their next meeting.
