## **DISCUSSION/ACTION REGARDING A REQUEST FOR CHANGES TO THE SIGNS AND LIGHTING AT EWALD KIA, LOCATED AT 36883 E. WISCONSIN AVENUE, IN THE BUSINESS DISTRICT OF THE VILLAGE OF OCONOMOWOC LAKE**

Mr. Wiemer noted that Mr. Brian Ewald was present to answer any questions from the Plan Commissioners. Ewald Kia requests permission to add two (2) additional 400 watt lamps to its existing three (3) front lot light poles. Additionally, Ewald Kia requests permission to change the “KIA” signage on the building and on the sign post. The size of the signs would not change; only the design of the sign would be changed per requirements of the Kia manufacturer. Discussion followed.
