1. An amendment of the Conditional Use Permit for Vic's Carpet & Flooring, located at 36105 and 36115 E. Wisconsin Avenue, in the Business District of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, for the purpose of adding a new tenant (AK's Trading Post Inc. selling sporting goods)
2. Chapter 17, Zoning Code, Sections 17.19(1)(e) and 17.19(2)(d) relating to the status of accessory structures when the residence is removed
3. An Ordinance to Repeal and Recreate Section 18.02(3)(c) and to Create Section 18.14(3) of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake Subdivision and Platting Ordinance, Related to the Sale and Exchange of Parcels of Land Between Abutting Owners
4. An Ordinance to Create Section 18.16 of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake Subdivision and Platting Ordinance, Regarding Financial Guarantees for Required Improvements
