Discussion to consider responses from the public regarding the Village of Oconomowoc Lake Plan Commission's recommendation that the Village Board of Trustees enact an Ordinance adopting an amended master plan for the Village of Oconomowoc Lake entitled "Village of Oconomowoc Lake Smart Growth Plan" pursuant to Sections 62.23 and 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

A public information meeting was held prior to this public hearing in order to inform residents of the Smart Growth Plan, and listen to any concerns they might have. Ms. Kathy Moore made a 45 minute presentation at the public information meeting that included why the Smart Growth Plan had to be created, how the plan was created, and where the information was obtained. She also presented an overview of each chapter of the plan. A copy of the minutes from that meeting is attached.

The following change was recommended to be made in the plan:

On page 18, section D3 should be changed to read "The Village should not permit or provide sanitary sewer service, unless such service is necessary to replace failing private septic systems, or those which threaten the quality of the lake."
