Public Hearing

A public hearing was held before the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, commencing at 7:00 PM, Monday, April 19, 2010, at the Village Hall, 35328 W. The request of Mr. Victor Raasch to amend his conditional use to allow one new business to lease the upper floor on the west side of his building located at 36115 and 36105 E. Wisconsin Avenue in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake business district. The proposed business is a tae kwon do studio.

Mr. Wiemer explained that the proposed tae kwon do studio will occupy the second floor of the western half of the building owned by Mr. Victor Raasch. The business uses two transport vans to pick up students from various schools for the tae kwon do classes. The conditional use permit amendment would permit the two vans to be parked on the northeast side of the property (36105 E. Wisconsin Avenue) in the two stalls on the north side of the fenced area after business hours. Additionally, the vans may be parked on the north side of the property during business hours. The operation hours of the tae kwon do studio are 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to noon Saturday, closed Sunday.

The request of Mr. Walter Garlock to amend his conditional use to revise his business operating hours and to include Sundays for servicing of vehicles at the Silver Lake Auto Center located at 36355 E. Wisconsin Avenue in the Village of Oconomowoc Lake business district.

Mr. Wiemer explained that Mr. Garlock has requested a change in the hours of operation for his business Silver Lake Auto Center. Currently the business is open for vehicle servicing Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. and closed on Sunday. The proposed hours of operation for servicing vehicles are Monday through Saturday from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. and on Sunday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Motion (Shult/Birbaum) to close the public hearing, at 7:05 p.m., Carried Unanimously.
